The Dorothy F. Schmidt College of Arts and Letters will award competitive study-abroad scholarships to our students who are planning to enroll in one of the summer study abroad programs that are being offered through the Dorothy F. Schmidt College of Arts and Letters this summer. The scholarships are competitive and a limited number will be awarded. The programs offered summer 2016 that are eligible are:

- **Salango, Ecuador:** Archeological and Ethnographic Fieldwork in Coastal Ecuador
- **Venice, Italy:** Italian Language, Culture and Geography
- **Berlin, Germany:** German Language and Culture
- **Orvieto, Italy:** Textures and Impressions
- **Fukuoka, Japan:** Exploring Japanese Language and Culture

Award Amount: up to \$1000

Eligibility:

- FAU student with a major in the Dorothy F. Schmidt College of Arts and Letters
- Enrolled in one of the College of Arts and Letters Study Abroad programs, listed above.
- Minimum GPA 3.0

Application Packet Requirements:

- Study abroad application form (form available in the Dean's office AH 214) or access the application online at: [Application Form](#)
- A one page, single spaced (12 pt font) typed personal statement detailing how the study abroad program that you have selected supports your academic, professional and personal goals.
- Current FAU unofficial transcript

Additional Requirements:

- Recipients of this award will be required to write a thank you letter to the DFSCAL Advisory Board
- Recipients of this award will be required to give a brief presentation of their experience to the DFSCAL Advisory Board in the Fall 2016 semester.
